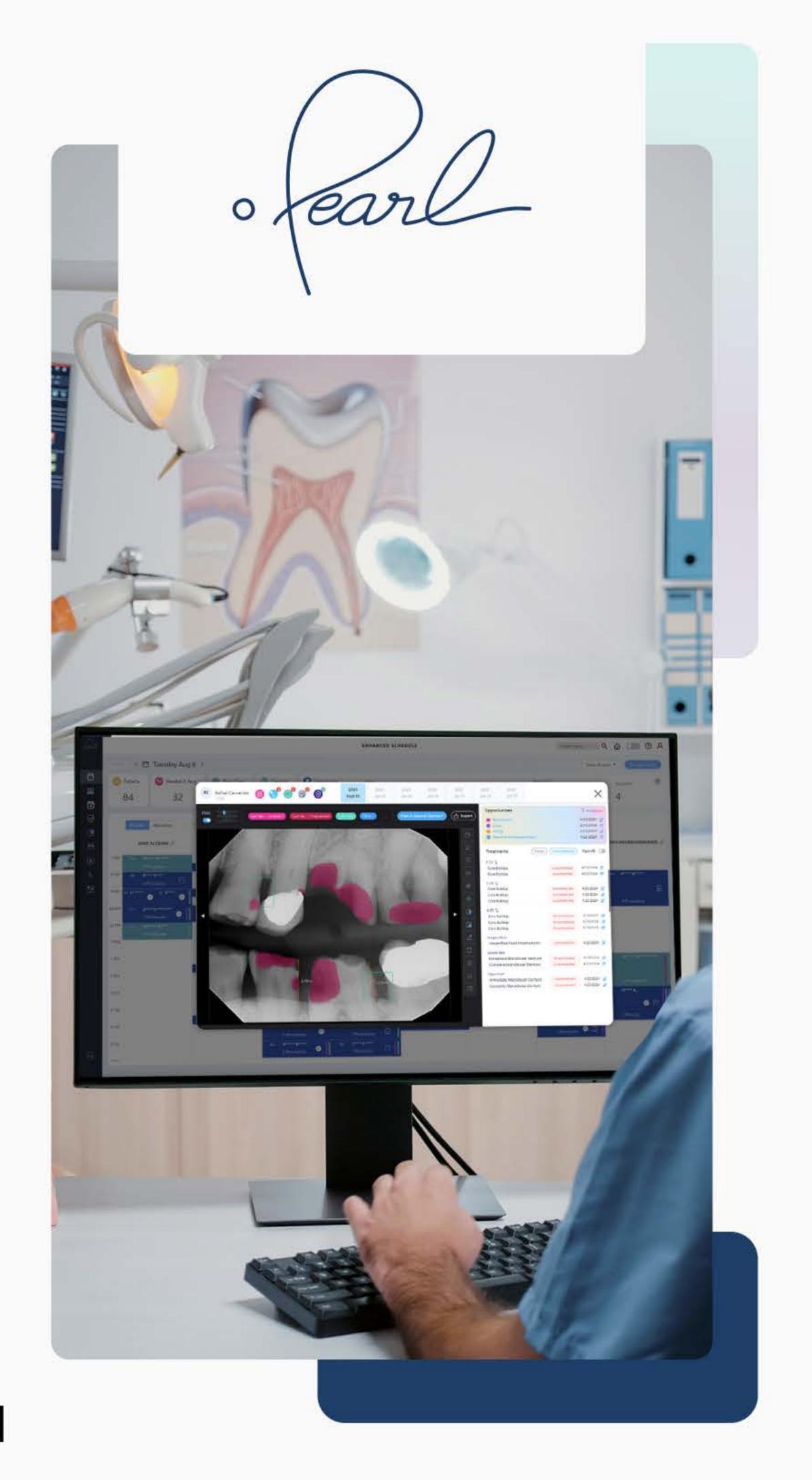

Approach

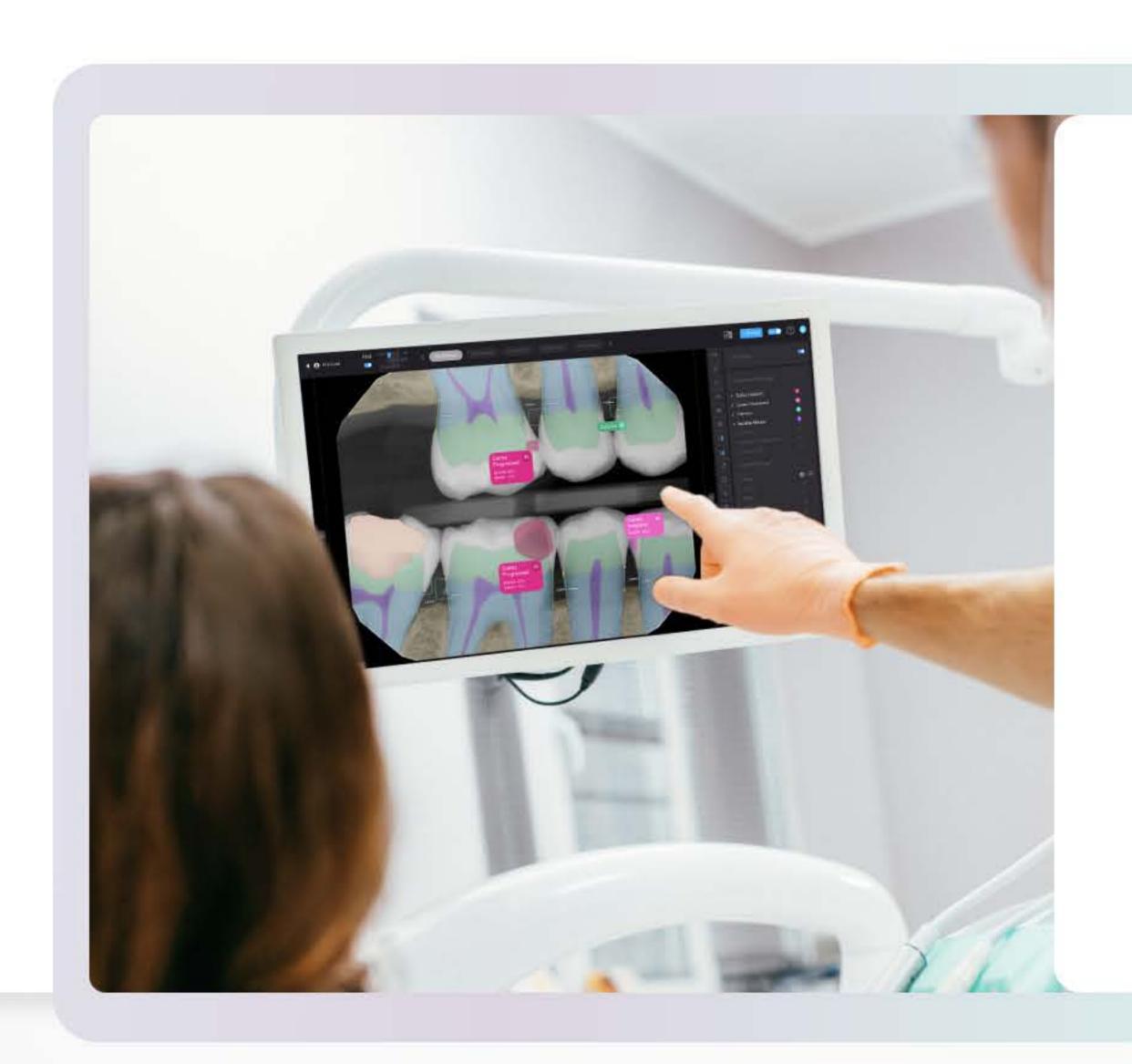
